ENTRIES CLOSE: - Oct 29, 2011, January 28, 2012, February 25, 2012

All entries must be received by 5:00 PM on the closing date. All entries must be accompanied by the entry fees, or late fees will be charged. Entries received after the closing date will be charged a late fee of \$20.00. **ONLY CASH & CHEQUE ACCEPTED.** Open Cheques OK. A \$30 NSF fee will be charged for all returned cheques: only cash accepted thereafter.

Classes of the same height may be run as an open card.

No cross entry between any medal classes on the same day.

In the event of a tie for a division championship, the rider with the most points over fences will be awarded the championship. If the over fences points are equal, the rider with the highest place ribbons wins.

Championship will only be awarded if more than 3 exhibitors ride in a division.

Hors Concours entries will only be accepted if time warrants.

Hors Concours entries must ride at the end of the class. All entry fee's apply to these entries.

Stallions are only to be ridden and handled by an adult. Unmanageable stallions will be asked to leave the competition by either the judge, steward or show committee.

PROTESTS:

Should a question or dispute arise, not provided for in the rules, it shall be referred to the Show Committee, whose decision will be final.

SCRATCHES AND CHANGES:

Exhibitors canceling after the closing date shall forfeit their entry fees except in the case of disability of a horse or rider. A Certificate of Disability from a qualified Veterinarian is required for a refund at the office.

CONFLICT AND ORDER OF GO:

Classes over 20 entries will be judged California split.

Horses must be available for pre-loading at the gate.

No gate holds allowed.

Please have horses ready to enter ring for presentations of ribbons and prizes.

SAFETY:

Helmets and other safe riding gear must be worn while mounted.

Helmets Must be ASTM approved.

All competitors must wear ASTM or BSI approved Helmets.

There is a **ZERO TOLERANCE TOWARD ALCHOL & DRUGS ON THE GROUND.**

Management and Board reserves the right to disqualify entries for disruptive and / or in appropriate behavior to member, participants, volunteers, officials or judges.

PARKING:

Is available in the lower parking lot for participants of the show.

Please remember to clean up the area around your trailers, this would include hay and garbage.

ENTRY DROP OFF:

Entries can be dropped off at Bridles & Bits and Buckerfields in Parksville or mailed.

STABLING

Stabling is very limited for the November Show, please contact Jenny Payne and is first come first served.

For Feb/March show stabling is not in the indoor, it is in an upper outdoor barn.

Tack rooms will be available if space allows. Any sawdust/bark mulch used around the stalls must be removed at the completion of the show.

Areas around the stalls and where hay is stored must be raked and left tidy at the completion of the show.

A \$50.00 clean stall deposit will be required. Stalls must be completely stripped of bedding/hay and swept. "please bring the necessary equipment and broom"

NOTE: numbers will not be given out until Stall deposit is paid.

PRIZE MONEY AND SHOW OFFICE

Prize money can be picked up at the show office at the end of the show.

Ribbons awarded to 6th place

High Point & Reserve High Point Ribbons to be awarded at each show.

Prizes awarded in all Divisions will be presented at the Awards banquet at the end of the Series. Show

office hours are 7:30 AM to 1/2 hour after the last class of the day

CHAMPIONSHIPS

All riders wishing to accumulate points in the Winter Series must volunteer a minimum of 4 hours at our show or point will not accumulate. You may have a family member or friend volunteer for you.

In order to qualify for Championships, riders must be a current and in good standing member of Oceanside Hunter Jumper Association. Points will be totaled for the three shows.

Same horse/rider combo must ride at least two of the current series shows.

Any horse/rider combination can ride in other divisions unless so stipulated in the program. However, horse/rider combinations can **only collect points for championships in one hunter division and/or one jumper division and must let the Entry Secretary know which division has been chosen on or before February 5, 2012.** Riders can collect points in a Jumper Medal and/or a Hunter Medal as well as their designated Jumper and/or Hunter divisions.
